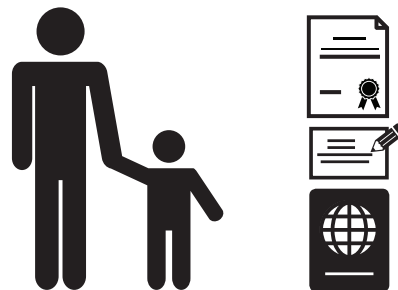
Travelling with kids? Be aware that children under the age of 18 travelling in and out of South Africa will be required to carry an **unabridged birth certificate** as well as a **valid passport** under new regulations aimed at improving the safety of children.

CHILD + BOTH PARENTS



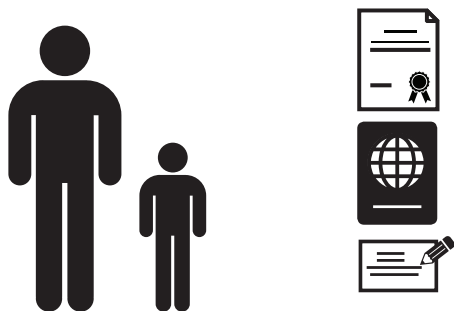
Parents must produce an **unabridged birth certificate** and a **valid passport**.

CHILD + 1 PARENT



Parent must produce an **unabridged birth certificate**, a **valid passport** and a **court order/death certificate/affidavit** confirming the absent parent has given permission for the child to travel.

CHILD + GUARDIAN ONLY



Guardian must produce an **unabridged birth certificate**, a **valid passport**, **court order/death certificate/affidavit** confirming the parents have given permission for the child to travel.

CHILD UNACCOMPANIED



Child must produce **unabridged birth certificate**, a **valid passport** and an **affidavit** confirming permission to travel from both parents or legal guardians and **letter from person** who will receive child in South Africa, including their full contact details and a **certified copy of their Passport or ID**.

An unabridged birth certificate is issued by the Department of Home Affairs and contains the details of both parents. We would encourage all our customers to apply as soon as possible to avoid any inconvenience. Speak to a Flight Centre Business Travel specialist for more information.
